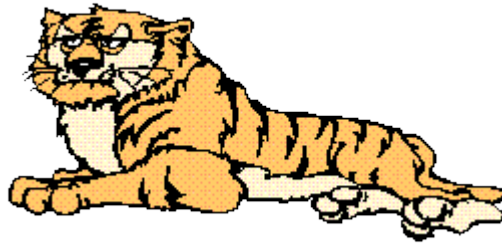


Save The Tigers!!!!



In Jackson Township, NJ there has been a lady by the name of Joan Byron-Marasek who has been keeping Bengal Tigers in a wildlife sanctuary for the last 21 years. This sanctuary is an open air facility surrounded by a wooded area. The Tigers are kept together in a spacious fenced-in pen, which allows them freedom of movement, and the ability to play and interact with one another, which is much more humane than a zoo. It is called the Tigers Only Preservation Society, and has been dedicated to preserving these animals who are an Endangered Species. Now the NJ government is trying to get the land the sanctuary is located on, forcing Joan into an expensive court battle to save the land and the tigers, who will be forced to move, and more than likely destroyed. Published reports had wildlife experts involved in the situation stating outright that the destruction of the 26 tigers in the sanctuary is an option if suitable homes cannot be found for them.

The Real Millennium Group is pledging our support of Joan and the Society in keeping the Tigers safe, and keeping developers from getting the property. Donations to help with the court battle is needed most. The society is a non-profit, tax-exempt organization (IRS Code 501(c)) so any donations will be tax deductible. Please help us in saving these Endangered Animals from the hands of the NJ government and the developers who desire the land and care nothing for the animals.
